Baby Calf Receiving Guidelines – Effective 12/22/03

1. This guideline is for baby calves going back to farms to be raised for Veal.
2. Guidelines for rejecting calves
  - A. *Navels*
    1. Hard all the way to the abdomen and a cord diameter of 1 ¾”
    2. Has puss, a bad smell, and/or is hot
  - B. *Weak, Unthrifty-dehydrated (sunken eyes and/or scouring)*
  - C. *Stale Calves showing the following signs:*
    1. Dull hair coat
    2. No layer of baby fat
    3. Excessive manure on them
  - D. *Severe respiratory*
  - E. *Conformation*
    1. A calf standing with back legs forward, pastern's weak and splayed hooves
    2. A calf with a swayed back, paunchy gut, high hip pins and a half moon back bone (from hips to tail head)
    3. Deep belly, stands low in the front
    4. A calf that is weak in the pasterns, dewclaws are touching the floor and the hoof is splayed
  - F. *Type*
    1. No leopard legged crossbreed
    2. No Brown Swiss
    3. No Jersey or Jersey crosses
    4. No crossbreed under 100 pounds
